*** is followed by our pediatric pulmonary department for primary ciliary dyskinesia which can cause chronic cough and runny nose. These symptoms can also get significantly worse even with a “minor” cold. At the first sign of any illness, *** follows a prescribed “sick plan” that is used to help improve symptoms and prevent worsening of respiratory infections.

There are times when *** requires respiratory treatments around the clock to prevent the need for hospitalization, which in turn may result in school absences. *** is a committed student; however, due to complications that can be associated with primary ciliary dyskinesia, I feel that a 504 plan would be of significant benefit to ***academically.
